BID–Needham currently has 58 licensed beds and over 600 physicians.

The expanded Cancer Center and Surgical Pavilion includes:

- 30,000 additional square-feet of space
 - 20,000 square-feet dedicated to cancer care and 10,000 square-feet for surgical services
- Two new Operating Rooms, allowing BID–Needham to double our surgical capacity from 2,500 to 5,000 surgeries annually within five years
- 11 chemotherapy bays, 10 overlooking a private tranquil garden and one private bay
- 12 new pre-operation and recovery bays
- A Linear Accelerator (LINAC) Vault on the first floor for radiation treatment

The new Beth Israel Deaconess Cancer Center and Surgical Pavilion–Needham is home to advanced diagnostics and therapies, and compassionate, team-based care from some of the most prominent experts in the world. The modern 30,000-square-foot facility spans three floors and provides the community with world-class cancer care and surgical services, without having to drive into Boston. The expanded Cancer Center and Surgical Pavilion helps BID–Needham achieve the following:

- **Larger, more efficient space for cancer services.** The new center was designed by the patient for the patient using focus groups. Two of the three floors in the new building are dedicated to cancer care. Patients undergoing active treatment, such as chemotherapy and radiation, are able to receive all of their treatment on one floor.
- **Accommodate the increase in demand for BID–Needham's surgical services.** The new building creates an entire floor of new space, including larger operating rooms (ORs), which streamlines surgical services and allow the hospital to serve even more surgery patients.
- **Enables BID–Needham to continue responding to the rapid changes in health care.** There is an increased emphasis on treating patients in community hospitals where they can receive high-quality care that is less expensive than urban hospitals and closer to home. The new building contributes not only to the financial health of the patient but also enables the hospital to handle the higher capacity and subsequent revenue.
- **Provide the ideal patient-centered experience.** With valuable input from focus groups made up of patients, family members, and various staff members, we created a plan that ensures every square foot of the building is designed with the patient in mind.
