The Greatest Needs Fund at Lahey Hospital & Medical Center provides immediate-use, unrestricted dollars to the hospital to direct resources where they are needed most. Philanthropic support to this fund ensures our ability to strategically invest in priorities that enhance patient care, advance our research and education enterprise, and maintain our standing as a leading provider of world-class healthcare.

Hospitals operate on extremely thin margins, and with the current healthcare landscape, operating expenses are rising faster than reimbursement rates. As a result, unrestricted support has become even more crucial to meet unexpected needs that emerge outside our annual budget. Dollar for dollar, the Greatest Needs Fund makes the most profound immediate impact on Lahey—allowing us to invest in the needs that sustain us today and the priorities that will advance us tomorrow.

The Greatest Needs Fund has helped make possible innovative programs and initiatives such as the following:

The Lahey Hospital Ambulance Service, Lahey's first in-house ambulance service, was launched in 2022 to help address capacity challenges by making the discharge process more efficient for staff and patients. The program has accomplished this goal and is improving the patient experience through expedited discharges and reduced wait times.

The Health & Wellness Department at Lahey was established to provide patient-facing colleagues with wide-ranging support, such as behavioral health and mindfulness resources and new wellness programs and initiatives—including the opening of the Serenity Suite in 2022, a quiet space for colleagues to take their breaks.

Through a collaboration with the Posse Foundation, Lahey launched a new summer internship program in the Department of Surgery in 2022. Each summer, this program offers five Posse Scholars from diverse backgrounds historically underrepresented in medicine the opportunity to gain valuable experience in the medical field and receive mentorship from Lahey leaders.

Lahey implemented the Justice, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (JEDI) collaborative pilot program in 2022 to train approximately 200 residents and fellows in developing skills and learning best practices to address bias in the workplace.

#### **Attracting and Retaining Diverse Talent**

As widespread staffing shortages continue to challenge and disrupt hospitals and healthcare institutions across the country, Lahey is responding with innovative ways to support and retain our current colleagues and recruit new candidates. - Expanding our summer recruitment program for nursing students to other employee groups, to increase our pipeline programs and inspire new graduates from a variety of healthcare programs to seek employment at Lahey.
- Renovating work spaces—such as replacing flooring and investing in modern furniture and equipment designed ergonomically—to increase the comfort, safety, and engagement of our staff.
